

DNP Portfolio Requirement

Your portfolio is an electronic collection of documents and media that reflect your achievement of program outcomes, professional goals, and accomplishments.

In the DNP program, the portfolio is used to document your accomplishment of the program outcomes and the DNP Essentials. The portfolio is evaluated as part of your course grade in NRS 8300, NRS 9300, and NRS 9100.

The purpose of your portfolio is to:

- Document your career goals, professional development, and achievement of program outcomes
- Facilitate reflective practice and critical thinking as you develop your portfolio
- Provide a resource to share with potential employers

You may have already set up an ePortfolio with the Career Center. It is fine to use this system. As another option for DNP students, we are providing the opportunity for you to use a “free” portfolio system of your choice. Follow this link to learn about free portfolio systems:

You will be able to use the portfolio system of your choice. When your portfolio is due you will submit the sharing link to your instructor.

Your portfolio should include the following:

Section	Component	Additional Detail
1	Professional history, personal information if desired Picture Professional goals	
2	Resume/Curriculum Vitae	
3	Program Outcomes	For each of the program outcomes (located below), use a new page in your e-portfolio. Include a narrative introduction that relates your professional goals to the outcome and attach artifacts (papers, presentations, pictures or written narratives). The narrative should also explain how the artifact supports your achievement of the program outcome. Each program outcome should have a minimum of 3 artifacts that represent your work throughout the program.
4	DNP Essentials	For each of the DNP Essentials, summarize both the class and clinical work that contributed to achievement of these essentials.
