Students are required to post this information prior to going to clinical and must have their clinical faculty or course coordinator’s approval to being rotations.



As a safety to this process, the Preceptor (see email above) also verifies the hours that the student submits. If the Preceptor does not agree with the hours recorded by the student, they simply click the link in the email and they can review the hours and disagree. The system is set up so that if a Preceptor disagrees with the listed clinical hours it triggers the student to check for errors and alerts Assistant Director by email who notifies the appropriate Program Coordinator for the student. As of this writing, notices of this sort have been from student error in entry and have been quickly fixed.

Review of Student Clinical – Types of Patients Seen and Experiences

Program Coordinators evaluate the students' documentations of the types of patients they have seen and the number of logged patient contacts they have had. This is done in the last semester of the student's program.
