- Assessment (Moore) See attached Power Point presentation. Course evaluations are assessment at course level and Compliance Assist is assessment at program level. EE has started collecting program completion rates, NCLEX pass rates, FNP certification pass rates, etc.
- Program Outcomes for FY17-BSN, RN-BSN, FNP, PMHNP, DNP=all goals met. Faculty Outcomes-teaching (did not meet), scholarship (met), service (met). Need to look at teaching and take mean of classes rather than mean of faculty. Faculty outcomes discussed and approved.
- USG lab fee analysis (MacMillan)-no increases or new course fees per President Dorman. SON has requested increase in Operating to offset if needed.
- SON Goals report (MacMillan)-see attached PowerPoint.
- ANEW Grant (Coke)-\$1.4 million over the next two years. NP students will go to medically underserved areas for five months of training. All but two FNP students accepted grant. Accepted another cohort of 13 FNP students comprised of GDPH nurses who will be able to do clinicals at health departments throughout Georgia.
- Elsevier (Greene)-Stacy Grein will be coming to present to faculty about upcoming changes. Revisit use of SimChart (only three courses use). Same questions on NCLEX review, how to change?
- ExamSoft (Greene)-All courses in BSN program will use ExamSoft exclusively for testing. Only on iPads and no personal laptops.
