All full-time faculty in the School of Nursing (SON) voted at the August 14, 2019 SON faculty retreat to deactivate the RN-BSN program. A motion was presented to the Nursing Faculty Organization (NFO) from the SON Curriculum Committee to deactivate this program.

Over the last five years, the program has seen a continued decline in enrollment despite significant recruitment efforts. Competition from priority schools offering the RN-BSN that require the completion of little or no core have made competition a difficult barrier to overcome. GC's rigorous requirements for completion of core which is primarily face to face on campus has also been a barrier.

Currently (Fall 2019) there are two students who are enrolled in NRSG 4100 Transition to Baccalaureate Nursing Practice. This is the final semester of the BSNC program for these students and they will graduate in December 2018. 2019

They have not applied to or have they been accepted to the BSNC program. The plan for these students is to reach out to them individually and assist them in finding another program to apply for.

A critical assessment of number of degrees conferred versus the required man-hours to sustain this program indicated that the SON efforts can be better served by focusing our man-hours on programs that are currently in high demand.

• The course/s required while enrolling in the course, such as: BIOL 1101 has the co-requisite BIOL 1101L.
