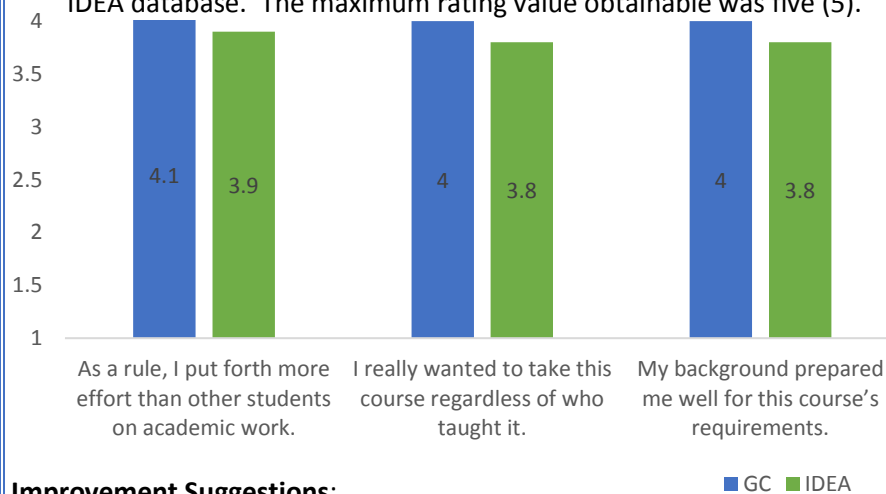


Student Rating of Instruction Survey (SRIS) Data Summary - Summer 2020

The table below shows the SRIS summary results for Summer 2020. Due to the migration of the SRIS to a new platform, which occurred during the Summer of 2019, the SRIS was not administered and there is no comparison data available to report for Summer 2019. Please note that Student Success does not offer courses in the summer, and, historically, Business does not administer the SRIS for any of its Summer courses.

Student Responses: This chart shows the average score of student self-ratings from the SRIS for Summer 2020. The two comparison groups are Georgia College students and other students from the IDEA database. The maximum rating value obtainable was five (5).



Improvement Suggestions:

- **SRIS Response Rates:** Offer departmental incentives, send reminders to students that encourages their participation and informs them of the purpose and importance of the survey, and allow students time in class to complete the survey where applicable
- **Excellent Teacher:** Build relationships at the beginning of each course, provide prompt and meaningful feedback, and offer students your support
